





Chronic pain affects more than **one-third** of people in the United States.¹



The number of overdose deaths from prescription pain relievers is more than all other drugs combined, including heroin and cocaine.¹


In 2014, there were 47,055 lethal drug overdoses. 18,893 of them were related to prescription pain relievers.²





Maine is seeing a sharp increase in opioid overdose deaths this year and prescription opioids were found in 64 percent of overdose victims.³

The number of prescriptions for opioids escalated from around 76 million in 1991 to over 200 million in 2013.1
